From the South:

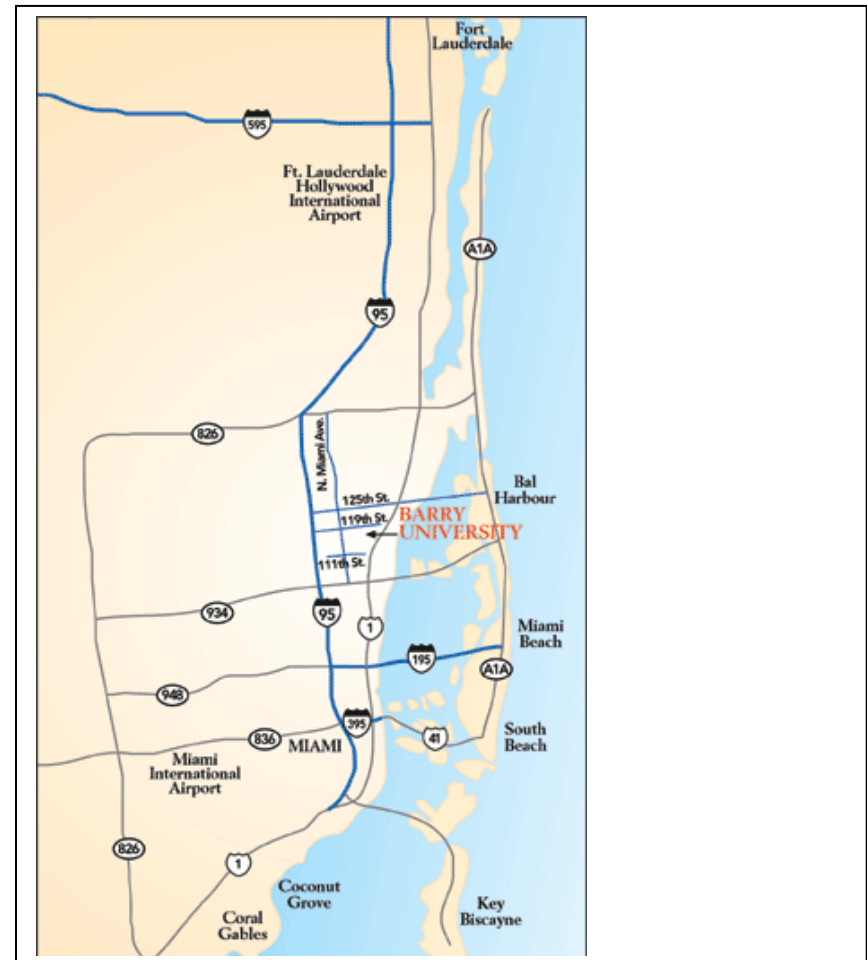

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. One half of the entry fee will be refunded upon request to the trial secretary for a bitch coming in season after the closing date of entries, provided the secretary is notified prior to the date of the trial.

ALL DOGS SHOULD BE PRESENT at least 30 minutes prior to Judging. The handler is solely responsible for having the dog at ringside. The steward will not search for you.

Exhibitors will be responsible for picking up after their own dogs. Once identified, those who do not pick up after their dogs will be excused from the trial WITHOUT refund. Please help us keep the show grounds and motel grounds clean.

CHILDREN must be accompanied by an adult and under control at all times.

“Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians’ recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.”

HOW TO USE THE ENTRY BLANK

Use one blank per dog only if all information is EXACTLY THE SAME FOR each day. Carefully check the blocks for each DAY, AND TRIAL in which you wish to enter your dog. You MUST use a SEPARATE entry blank for each trial if you are entering your dog in a different class at a different trial. (Obedience and Rally entries may be on the same entry form IF they are for the same dog in the same classes.)

RALLY EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

If your Rally class requires a jump height (because the class will be ordered by jump height) you MUST supply a jump height on your entry form or the trial secretary will not accept your entry. The Trial Secretary will not contact you for this information-- example: Rally Novice Move ups to Advanced, Rally Advanced to Excellent classes)

NON-REGULAR CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Wild CARD NOVICE - The Wild Card Novice class is for any dog that is capable of performing the Novice exercises and that is eligible under the *Obedience Regulations* to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter and handlers may enter more than one dog. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person, and may be entered in another class or classes. The Novice exercise will be performed and judged as in the regular Novice class, except that verbal praise during the exercises is to be encouraged and not penalized. (Good, yes, nice, super, great, attaboy, are some examples of praise that would be allowed.) Handlers may give additional commands, but they will be penalized accordingly. Each handler may choose to select one exercise as a wild card. The exhibitor will have the option of performing the selected wild card exercise, but will receive the full point value regardless of how the dog performs. When checking in, the handler must inform the steward or judge which exercise will be used as the wild card. The exercises will be performed in the same order as the regular Novice class. The point values for the exercises, scoring, and maximum total points are the same as the regular Novice class..

WILD CARD OPEN - The Wild Card Open class is for any dog capable of performing the Open exercises and that is eligible under the *Obedience Regulations* to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter and handlers may enter more than one dog. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person, and may be entered in another class or classes. The Open exercises will be performed and judged as in the regular Open A class, except that verbal praise during the exercises is to be encouraged and not penalized. (Good, yes, nice, super, great, attaboy, are some examples of praise that would be allowed.) Handlers may give additional commands, but they will be penalized accordingly. Each handler may choose to select one exercise as a wild card. The exhibitor will have the option of performing the selected wild card exercise, but will receive the full point value regardless of how the dog performs. When checking, the handler must inform the steward or judge which exercise will be used as a wild card. The exercises will be performed in the same order as in the regular Open A class. The point values for the exercises, scoring, and maximum total points are the same as in the regular Open class.

WILD CARD UTILITY - The Wild Card Utility class is for any dog that is capable of performing the Utility exercises and that is eligible under the *Obedience Regulations* to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter and handlers may enter more than one dog. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person, and may be entered in another class or classes. The Utility exercises will be performed and judged as in the regular Utility A class, except that verbal praise during the exercises is to be encouraged and not penalized. (Good, yes, nice, super, great, attaboy, are some examples of praise that would be allowed.) Handlers are allowed to praise their dogs during the performance of all Utility exercises except the signal exercise. Handlers may give additional commands, but they will be penalized accordingly. Each handler may choose to select one exercise as a wild card. The exhibitor will have the option of performing the selected wild card exercise, but will receive the full point value regardless of how the dog performs. When checking in, the handler must inform the steward or judge which exercise will be used as a wild card. The exercises will be performed in the same order as in the regular Utility A class. The point values for the exercise, scoring, and maximum total points are the same as in the regular Utility class.

TROPHIES

A qualifying score is required for all Regular Class prizes and ribbons. All Trophies must be picked up at the Trials - none will be mailed.

This is a condensed form of Premium List, as provided for in Chapter 6, Section 2A of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows. A list of obedience and rally prizes and trophies offered can be obtained by writing to Gina Reed, Trophy Chairperson, 1142 NE 92 Street, Miami FL 33138.

Move-ups

After a dog earns a title in either Obedience or Rally, it may be moved up to the next class in a future trial even though the closing date of the trial has passed. This move-up may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. The request for a move-up must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary for Saturday, May 29th, by Monday, May 24th by 6:00 pm. Move-ups for Sunday, May 30th, must be submitted by the close of the trial on Saturday, May 29th. Move-ups may be approved, provided the next level class and judges are available and the class has not reached its limit. **NO MOVE-UPS EITHER MORNING.**

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (we) agree that any cause of action, controversy or claim arising out of or related to the entry, exhibition or attendance at the event between the AKC and the event-giving club (unless otherwise stated in its premium list) and myself (ourselves) or as to the construction, interpretation and effect of this Agreement shall be settled by arbitration pursuant to the applicable rules of the American Arbitration Association.
